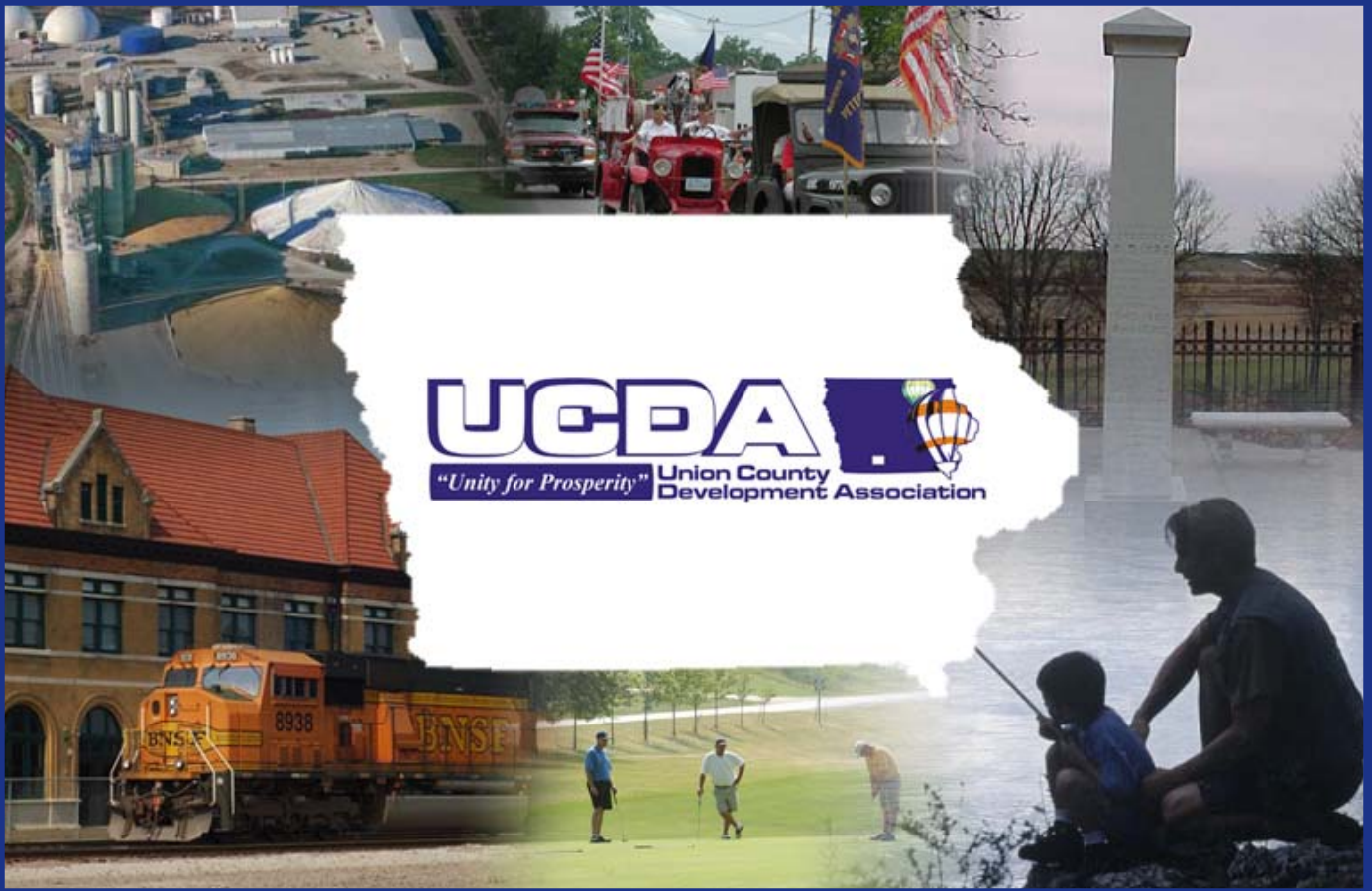

Location

Union County, Iowa is located 70 miles southwest of Des Moines, the State Capitol of Iowa. Creston - The county seat is 35 minutes from Interstates 35 & 80 which intersect the center of Iowa. Air connections to all major markets are within two hours from Union County to Des Moines, Omaha or Kansas City. BNSF Railway provides the primary rail service. Known as "Iowa's High Lakes Country" Union County is a haven for outdoor enthusiast. There are five lakes within 10 minutes of Creston. The community of Afton is the "Gateway" to Three-Mile Lake.

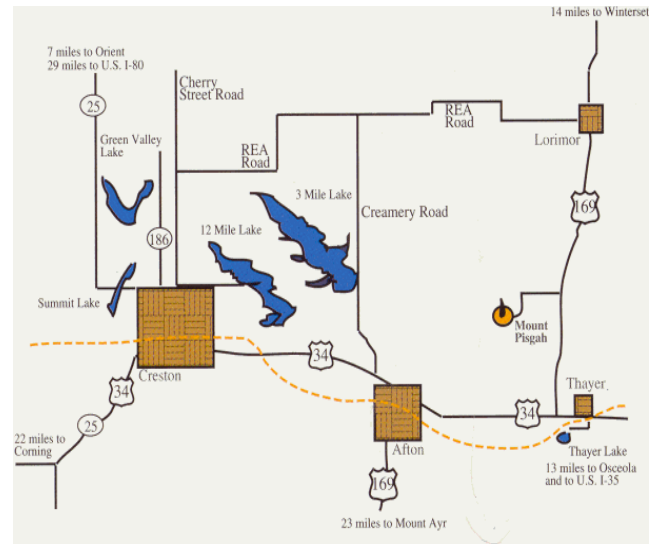
